### CONGRATULATIONS TO ZAC GARTON

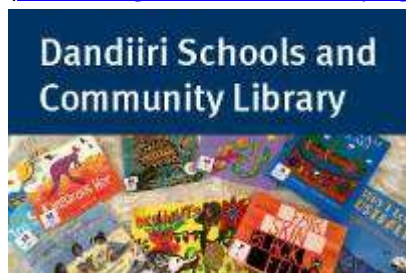
