Tennis Gympie Primary School Challenge Years 1 to 6

Tennis Gympie will be holding a **Primary School Challenge** at The Reg English Memorial Tennis Centre on Cartwright Road on **Thursday 22nd June from 3.30pm to 5.30pm**. The **cost is \$10 per player, \$15 for 2 players** from the same family or **\$20 for 3 or more players** from the same family **including a free sausage sizzle**. The challenges will be based on our Hot Shots Tennis in Schools programs and Holiday Fun Tournament events and all players will be placed into groups of appropriate skill levels (e.g. Red, Orange and Green Ball Levels). **Note:** Players from the winning school must play a minimum of **4 challenges** to be eligible for a medallion.
